Things Explained

TICKETING AND SHOW POLICIES

We suggest patrons arrive at the venue at least 15 minutes before the performance start time, as all performances are General Seating.

NO LATECOMERS – because of the set up of our venues, patrons will not be admitted after the performance starts (no, not even one minute after). With so many performances taking place, it is imperative that we stay on schedule. Therefore, performances start precisely at their designated show times, and no one is admitted once the show has started.

NO REFUNDS – because the Fringe returns 100% of ticket revenue (less GST and \$1.50 ticketing surcharge) to the artists, we cannot offer refunds on their behalf.

NO ADMITTANCE FOR PATRONS UNDER 18 YRS OLD FOR RESTRICTED OR R - RATED SHOWS - EVEN WITH PARENTAL CONSENT. Restricted shows are not deemed appropriate for patrons under the age of 18 years. The Calgary Fringe reserves the right to ask for ID at the door in this instance.

UNCLAIMED PRE-PURCHASED TICKETS - any tickets that were purchased in advance that have not been claimed will be released for resale to the general public 2 min prior to each performance start time.

membership fee assists with the theatre venue rental costs, technician wages, lighting, staging and sound. At the end of the day, it keeps the Fringe artists' participation costs way down so we can continue giving the Fringe artists 100% of their artist set ticket price!

IMPORTANT NOTE!! No Fringe Button


means **No Admittance** to the show, even if you have a ticket! This Button, along with your show ticket, gains you entry into the venue.

All Fringe Buttons are **\$5.00 per button** and can be purchased (CASH SALES ONLY!) at any of our box office locations. Fringe Buttons are required by all Fringe patrons age 13 and over. Up to four children, age 12 and under, can accompany one adult with a Fringe Button.

HOW MUCH OF THE TICKET PRICE ACTUALLY GOES TO THE FRINGE ARTIST?

 The Fringe Artist selects a base ticket price between \$8.50 per ticket to a maximum of \$13.50 per ticket. Whatever base ticket price the Fringe artist sets, they get back... 100%!

2. The Calgary Fringe then adds a ticketing surcharge of \$1.50 on top of the artist set base ticket price. That ticketing surcharge helps offset some of the Fringe box office related expenses, such as online ticketing merchant fees levied by Visa, Mastercard, and Debit, box office support, and ticket printing.
